#### 2005 Master Harriers of the Year Report

The USATF Cross Country Council's Executive Committee announced its 2005 Masters Harrier of the Year award winners on December 2<sup>nd</sup> at the Annual Meeting in Jacksonville, FL. The winners, both aged 46 and both winning for the first time, are **Carmen Ayala-Troncoso** of Austin, TX and **David O'Keeffe** of Orchard Park, NY.

The award is open to all registered USATF master athletes (ages 40+) who have competed in at least one of the USATF National Master Cross Country Championships between Annual Meetings. A unique variation in the championship schedule this year led to four Master XC Championships instead of the usual three: Portland, OR (12/04/04), Vancouver, WA (02/12/05), Saratoga Springs, NY (10/16/05) and Rochester, NY (11/19/05). The Club XC Championships (12/4/2004) were held after the 2004 USATF Annual Meeting so the results were included in the 2005 Harriers of the Year determination. The 2005 Club XC Championships in Rochester, NY (11/19/2005) were held at the earliest date in decades and thus prior to the 2005 USATF Annual Meeting. Thus, their results were also included in the 2005 Harriers of the Year determination. Selection was based on the age-graded results of these four Championships. Care must be taken when considering age-graded results in cross country. Be sure to compare each championship race as a separate event and not to rate one race's results against another due to differences in conditions like weather, terrain and accuracy of measurement.

Carmen Ayala-Troncoso dominated the 2005 national women's cross country scene as she not only age-graded on top in three of the four races, but won all four races. She was topped in age-graded results only at the Portland 6k by Kathryn Martin. David O'Keeffee age-graded on top at the 5k at Saratoga Springs, was 2<sup>nd</sup> at Rochester and 7<sup>th</sup> at Vancouver in the three events he participated.

Missing from the award platform is 5-timer winner Tom Dalton who suffered from a bout of Lyme Disease this past summer and did not return to top form, although he did run well at Saratoga Springs and Rochester.
