2004 Master Harriers of the Year Report

The USATF Cross Country Council's Executive Committee announced its 2004 Master Harriers of the Year award winners on December 3rd at the Annual Meeting in Portland, OR. The winners are **Kathryn Martin** of Northport, NY and **Tom Dalton** of Schenectady, NY. This is Kathryn Martin's 3rd consecutive Master Harrier of the Year award. Tom Dalton has won this award every year since its inception in 2000. This is his 5th consecutive win.

The award is open to all registered USATF master athletes (ages 40+) who have competed in at least one of the USATF National Master Cross Country Championships between Annual Meetings. A unique variation in the championship schedule this year led to four Master XC Championships instead of the usual three. The 2003 National Club XC Championships in Greensboro, NC was held on 12/7/2003 after the USATF annual meeting and featured 10k races for both Master Men and Master Women. 2004 saw an additional three separate cross country national championships for Master runners. The USATF Cross Country Championships and World Cup Trials were held in snowy Indianapolis, IN on 2/7/2004 where Master Men and Master Women both raced 6k. There were two 'stand-alone' Master XC Championships in the fall of 2004. Boston, MA hosted the Masters 8k XC event on 11/7/2004 at venerable Franklin Park. Saratoga Springs, NY hosted the Master 5k XC Championships at the challenging Saratoga Spa State Park course. Selection was based on the age-graded results of these four Championships. Care must be taken when considering age-graded results in cross country. Be sure to compare each championship race as a separate event and not to rate one race's results against another due to differences in conditions like weather, terrain and accuracy of measurement.

Kathryn Martin won the age grading at the two east coast championships besting Carmen Ayala-Troncoso and two-time Harrier of the Year Carolyn Smith-Hanna. Carmen Ayala-Troncoso was the top age grader at the Indy event. Regina Joyce was tops at Greensboro. Tom Dalton also won the age grading at the two east coast events while Pete Magill won in Indy and was second to Robert Winn in Greensboro. Dalton topped Magill in head-to-head competition at his home course in Saratoga Springs, NY to claim the Harrier of the Year award for the 5th straight year.
