2003 Master Harriers of the Year Report

The USATF Cross Country Council's Executive Committee announced its 2003 Master Harriers of the Year award winners on December 6th at the Annual Meeting in Greensboro, NC. There were co-winners for both Master Men and Master Women. The winners are **Kathryn Martin** of New York and **Shirley Matson** of California for the Master Women and **Tom Dalton** of New York and **Robert Winn** of Massachusetts for the Master Men. This is Kathryn Martin's 2nd consecutive Master Harrier of the Year award and the first for Shirley Matson. Tom Dalton has won this award every year since its inception in 2000. This is his 4th consecutive win and the first win for Robert Winn. The award is open to all registered USATF master athletes (ages 40+) who have competed in at least one of the USATF National Master Cross Country Championships between Annual Meetings.

There were four national Master Cross Country Championships between annual meetings. The 2002 National Club XC Championships at Sierra College in windy Rocklin, CA on 12/14/2002. 2003 saw an additional three separate cross country national championships for Master runners. The USATF Cross Country Championships (Winter Nationals) were held at Buffalo Bayou Park in Houston, TX on 2/15/2003 where Master Men and Master Women both raced 6k. There were two 'stand-alone' Master XC Championships in the fall of 2003. Rochester, NY hosted the Masters 8k XC event on 11/2/2003 at Black Creek Park where the 160m ski slope challenged all. Holmdel, NJ hosted the Master 5k XC Championships at hilly Holmdel Park on 11/23/2003. Selection was based on the age-graded results of these four Championships. Care must be taken when considering age-graded results in cross country. Be sure to compare each championship race as a separate event and not to rate one race's results against another due to differences in conditions like weather, terrain and accuracy of measurement. Kathryn Martin won the age grading at the two east coast championships while Shirley Matson was 2nd age grade in Houston behind AG champ Carmen Ayala-Troncoso on her home course. The Committee considered a West Regional event where Matson topped the age grading. Regina Joyce was age graded best in Greensboro with a small Master Women's field.

Tom Dalton also won the age grading at the two east coast events while Robert Winn topped the age grading at both events west of the Mississippi. They never met head-to-head.
