- 2. 10k USATF Winter National Masters Cross Country Championship held at Fort Vancouver Park, Vancouver, Washington on February 17, 2001.

- 4. 5k USATF National Masters Cross Country Championship held at Sperling Sports Complex, Deland, FL on November 18, 2001.

Note: I was not the USATF Masters Cross Country Rep. in 2000 but I did compete in this event. I ran 23:37 and finished 23rd of 30 Master Men. I was 4th in the M50-54 age group. Race Director John Boyle, the Vice-Chair of Masters LDR, offered to host the race at the last minute after a cancellation. This was shortly after the 911 attack and many people were still afraid to fly so, it was a very small field (30 men, 8 women). The 'official' age graded results published were calculated using the age grade adjusted times. I have used the 1996 age graded tables to generate the above age graded per cents with no change in the published age graded placings. – Bill Quinlisk
